

# ADMISSIONS

## Entrance Requirements

Neuchâtel Junior College selects students on the basis of their academic performance, character, interests and talents. Successful applicants are those who are looking to complete an established record of academic success with a stellar year of intense personal and intellectual growth. The College favours students who respond constructively to new challenges and who express sufficient maturity, international understanding and responsibility.

### A complete application includes the following:

1. A completed Application for Admission form.
2. A Recommendation from a Current Teacher form, completed by a current teacher of either English, Math, or Science.
3. A Letter of Recommendation (Character Reference) completed by either a current or former high school teacher (any subject), or a professional individual/organization for whom you have done volunteer work.
4. An Official Transcript listing all of your secondary school marks and credits earned as of June of last year, including any summer courses taken, if applicable.
5. A copy of each report card to date in the current academic year.
6. A 500 word essay from the applicant on the following: Neuchâtel Junior College fosters a culture of CPR - courtesy, peace and respect. What does this concept mean to you and how do your actions support this type of learning environment? What additional qualities do you value in your peers and teachers? Link this concept to Neuchâtel Junior College and explain what you hope to gain from attending the school, and what you would contribute to the school.
7. A statement from the applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s) outlining their support for your application, and for the College's programs, policies, and expectations of students.
8. A non-refundable application processing fee of \$175.00 Cdn.
